MONDAY MORNING:

- Arrive at 8:00 am to drop off instruments in the BGA Middle School foyer (look for directional signs).
- Proceed to check in at Harlin Student Center registration – get your JAM stage pass & make sure everything is on file.
- Group assembly starts at 8:30 am.
- **FINAL PAYMENT & ALL FORMS are due Monday morning before Assembly.**
- If you have not paid tuition in full or completed all your forms, please arrive at **7:45 am** to take care of your paperwork. **Your student may not attend class until everything is on file & paid for.**

BRING TO THE JAM:

- Lunch daily (**label your lunch**) – refrigeration is not available; drinks & snack concessions are for sale
- Dinner money for Thursday & Friday evenings (bring \$5 each night)
- For Monday, bring ideas for your Showcase Band session – songs on CDs or ipods with lyric sheets for your bandmates. You must be completely prepared to get started with your band on Monday.
- Instrument & everything you need for it (*LABEL EACH PIECE*):
 - o Keyboard (pedals, cords, stool)
 - o Guitar (capos, extra strings, picks)
 - o Bass
 - o Drums (stool, sticks)
 - o Horn etc.
- Amp & cords (**LABEL EVERYTHING**)
- Notebook and pen/pencil **EVERYDAY**
- Water

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Each day will begin with Group Assembly in Harlin Student Center – **8:30 sharp!**
- Students should be picked up at the Middle School – **3:00 pm sharp!**
- LABEL EVERYTHING (including lunch, since it is left in the cafeteria)
- You **MUST** bring your own instrument! The JAM does not provide instruments.
- Instruments & amps will stay on campus, secured in the classrooms overnight.
- Snack concessions are available for purchase throughout the week.
- No wi-fi (and therefore no email/internet) on campus
- A limited number of JAM t-shirts are for sale at \$12 each. See the registration table in Harlin.
- Students are required to stay after camp on Thursdays & Fridays until the evening performance is over. They will be rehearsing & doing soundchecks. Bring \$5 each night for dinner.
- Concessions will be available for purchase during the performance nights.
- The JAM is intense – get plenty of rest and drink lots of water during JAM week!
- The Kona Ice Van (sno-cones) will be on site Friday afternoon & night, bring extra \$ for this cool treat!

- On **Wednesday**, band poster photos will be made during the day.
