TUESDAY MORNING:

- Arrive at 8:00 am to drop off instruments (drums & keyboards load in on Sunday, July 3, 3-6pm) in the BGA Middle School foyer (look for directional signs).
- Proceed to check in at Harlin Student Center registration – get your JAM name tag & wristband, make sure everything is on file, & check out your band assignments.
- Group assembly starts at 8:30 am.
- **FINAL PAYMENT & ALL FORMS are due Monday morning before Assembly.**
- If you have an outstanding balance or forms due, please arrive at **7:45 am** and go to the **Will Call** table. **Your student may not attend class until everything is on file & paid for.** Save your student the hassle of the Will Call line, and pay PRIOR to JAM Monday!

BRING TO THE JAM:

- Lunch daily (label your lunch) – refrigeration is not available; drinks & snack concessions are for sale
- **For Tuesday, bring ideas for your Showcase Band session** – songs on CDs or ipods with lyric sheets for your bandmates. You must be completely prepared to get started with your band on Tuesday.
- Instrument & everything you need for it (**LABEL EACH PIECE**):
 - o Keyboard (pedals, cords, stool)
 - o Guitar or Bass (capos, extra strings, picks)
 - o Drums (stool, sticks)
 - o Horn etc.
- Amps, cords, cables (LABEL EVERYTHING)
- 9V battery (if using)
- Notebook and pen/pencil EVERYDAY
- Water

DRUM & KEYBOARD LOAD-IN - (BGA Middle School – look for signs)

- **Sunday, July 3, 3:00 pm – 6:00 pm** - Drummers bring pad or carpet for under drums

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Each day will begin with Group Assembly in Harlin Student Center – **8:30 sharp!**
- Students should be picked up at the Middle School – **3:00 pm sharp!**
- LABEL EVERYTHING
- You **MUST** bring your own instrument & amp! The JAM does not provide instruments.
- Instruments & amps will stay on campus, secured in the classrooms overnight.
- All acoustic guitars must have a pick-up for amplification
- Snack concessions are available for purchase throughout the week.
- No wi-fi (and therefore no email/internet) on campus
- A limited number of JAM t-shirts are for sale at \$15 each at the concessions table – buy early!
- Students are required to stay after camp on Friday & Saturday until the evening performance is over. They will be rehearsing & doing soundchecks. Dinner will be provided on those nights.
- Concessions will be available for purchase during the performance nights.
- Shuff's will have a mini-store on campus - drumsticks, picks, straps, strings and more.
- Do not bring longboards to the JAM – they will be confiscated

- On **Thursday**, band poster photos will be made during the day.

RULES of THE JAM
